1 specimen bag (with absorbent pad)

SPECIMEN ONLY



1 collection tube

1 vaginal swab

READ FIRST


- 1. Read all instructions thoroughly before collecting your specimens.
- 2. Do not drink alcohol on the day of collection.
- during menstruation or within 24 hours of intercourse.
- 4. Collection tubes may contain a liquid preservative. **DO NOT EMPTY** LIQUID PRESERVATIVE FROM THE

3. Do not collect vaginal swab specimen

COLLECTION TUBES IF PRESENT.




Place lid onto the collection tube and ensure it is closed evenly and tightly.



Hold the swab between the faint score line (if present) and the cotton-tipped portion of the swab in one hand and separate the labia (folds of skin around the vaginal opening).


Write your date of birth in MM/DD/YYYY format onto the tube in the designated area (DOB).



TO PREVENT REJECTED SPECIMENS, PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING COLLECTION

Insert the swab 5cm (2in) into the vaginal opening. Gently turn the swab for 30 seconds while rubbing the swab against the walls of the vagina.




Write the specimen collection date (today's date) in MM/DD/YYYY format onto the tube in the designated area (Coll. Date).



Carefully withdraw the swab and place into the collection tube marked with a RED "VAGINAL" LABEL. Break the swab by bending against the collection tube.

Place specimen into the empty biohazard bag with the absorbent pad and ensure the seal is closed completely.
